Board Meeting Minutes * July 21, 2026

Opening Business

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes: Motion by Kim, seconded by Amber. Board approved; motion carried.

Monthly Reports

Secretary: Kelly reported nothing to report.

Treasurer: Edward Jones Mutual fund balance is \$126,667.88. This is up \$1,749.62 from June's report. The current checking account balance is \$2,217.73. The total of all accounts is \$128,885.61, down \$627.24 from June's report. Motion to approve Treasurer report by Kory, seconded by Brian . Board approved; motion carried. Kory questioned if the van gasoline charge was going to be allocated to anything. Mitch reported he just runs the van from time to time, such as running errands for Dog Days 5k and will also use for the Kid's Clinic practice run.

Equipment: Van remains at Mary Jane Pratt's residence. Inventory discussion held. Mitch will inspect water jugs and the megaphone.

Website: No newly submitted races. Website functioning properly. Minutes and event photos posted. Kory received prior minutes from Kelly to upload.

Pacesetter: Bob confirmed articles are due August 10, 2026. Twelve to thirteen runner profiles have been distributed with one person responding to date. Kory requested that the Run the Path sponsor receive copies of next issue.

Circuit Status 2026: Mitch reported all events progressing well.

Old Business

Kids Clinic/Women's Clinic update discussed. Women's Running Clinic is progressing well; one session canceled due to lightning. About half of shirts distributed. Mitch suggested that some of the kids should look to run the 1 mile instead of the 5k at the Boo Milby. Kelly spoke to Joanne Milby about this and she was on board with this idea. Joe pointed out that this was a great group of kids at this year's clinic and expressed appreciation for those that chaperoned and volunteered. Brittany confirmed with Mitch that they will have a pizza party for the kids in a few weeks.

2026 Club Challenge registration closed. Reward options under review. Some ideas discussed were transition blankets, duffel bags and coolers. Kory plans to obtain quotes from Creative Apparel.

Club credit card transferred; Cathy Berry removed as a user.

Boo Milby Race currently at 67 registrations, 21 ahead of last year.

Turkey Trot contract Mitch met with Holly via phone conversation, contract is expected next month.

Discussion held regarding race director information storage and accessibility. Kory's thought was item such as a shared drive/ cloud service so the information can be accessed should something happen to the RD

New Business

Music royalty fees discussed. Pandora would cost \$30/mo, \$360/yr. Bob said this would not be a workable option

Race reviews provided. Run the Plank had lower numbers than last year, Genesis 5K was a very well run race with 3,000 runners, Streater Run for Glory had 202 registrants with 180 crossing the finish line, Kim gave a special shout out to Joe for volunteering. Dog Days 5K was cooler than usual and ended up with 130 runners. Mitch is looking to put out a survey regarding the participant's feelings toward the parking. He thanked Randy and rest of volunteers. The step and repeat and Lake Run Club flags were utilized for photos, Ladd Days distance was short, at 2.95 miles. They had 87 finishers. There was no lead car and the age groups were a little inaccurate. Walnut was cancelled due to weather and Dixon took off an hour late.

Kim confirmed her Election Committee chair role. An eligible member list is to be provided by Kory. Bob and Kim both confirmed they will step down from the Board next term.

A motion was made by Kory, seconded by Kelly, to spend up to \$80 for a club credit card reader. Board approved; motion carried.
